

Silas Survives Berlin Looks To Pocono

(Harrisburg, N.C. 7/28/09) - ARCA RE/MAX Series driver Bryan Silas went into Berlin on a mission; to obtain a top ten finish. Bryan did that this weekend and was surprisingly happy with his car after practice. When qualifying rolled around Silas left a little on the table giving him a fifteenth place start.



When the green flag dropped Bryan set his sights on getting to the front. Lap after lap Silas improved his position, gaining valuable ground on the leaders. On lap sixty nine Bryan came into the pits for two tires and a track bar adjustment. Bryan was set up for an awesome night when an incident involving two other cars questioned Bryan's determination. The #11 had a lot of body damage, but his Fast Track crew went to work on his car only losing two laps. "I got a little discouraged after the accident but Andy and Cal kept my head in the game," said Silas.

Bryan was two laps down but not out. The caution filled race would end up being Silas' friend, giving him the chance to get both of his laps back. Bryan kept his head on and drove a smart race. A late race caution extended the race by seven laps which gave Silas a chance to plan his attack. He raced right up until the checkered flag fell and drove his way from two laps down to finishing ninth place on the lead lap.

Bryan will now set his sights on Pocono which is next up on the ARCA RE/MAX Series schedule.

The tricky triangle was not kind to Silas earlier this year. Several cut down tires left Silas with a fifteenth place finish. Bryan is looking to show Pocono who is boss. "I am looking forward to heading back to Pocono. I think the Fast Track team and I can redeem ourselves there this weekend," commented Silas.

Bryan goes to Pocono sixth in points, only thirty five points out of fifth place. "One of my main goals this year is to finish in the top five in points," said Silas.

The Pennsylvania ARCA 200 will take place this Saturday, August 1st. The race consists of 80 laps / 200 miles.
