

Silas Heads to Mansfield with High Hopes

(Harrisburg, NC – 6/17/09) - Fresh off of an outstanding run in Michigan, Bryan Silas heads to Mansfield Motorsports Park with hopes of obtaining his first win in the ARCA RE/MAX Series.



“I have never raced at Mansfield before but I think we can carry the momentum on at that track and come out with at least a top-5 finish,” said Silas. The momentum Bryan talks about comes from his ninth place finish last week at Michigan International Speedway. Heading into Saturday’s race Bryan sits fourth in points and plans to continue his march up the standings.

Silas isn’t worried about never having set foot on the track. He feels that he and his Fast Track Racing team, headed by crew chief Cal Boprey, are more than capable of meeting the challenge. “We have a great short track program and I definitely think that it is our strong point,” added Silas.

The Tim Richmond Memorial 200 slated for Saturday 6/20/09 will be broadcast live on arcaracing.com, and consists of 200 laps / 100 miles. The race is scheduled to kick off at 8:30 PM.

Nason, Yeager, Gerson, White & Lioce P.A., Holland Pump, Oasis Outsourcing, Palm Beach Grading (PBG), and Rockingham Speedway will be riding along with Bryan when he takes the green flag at Saturday night’s race.
